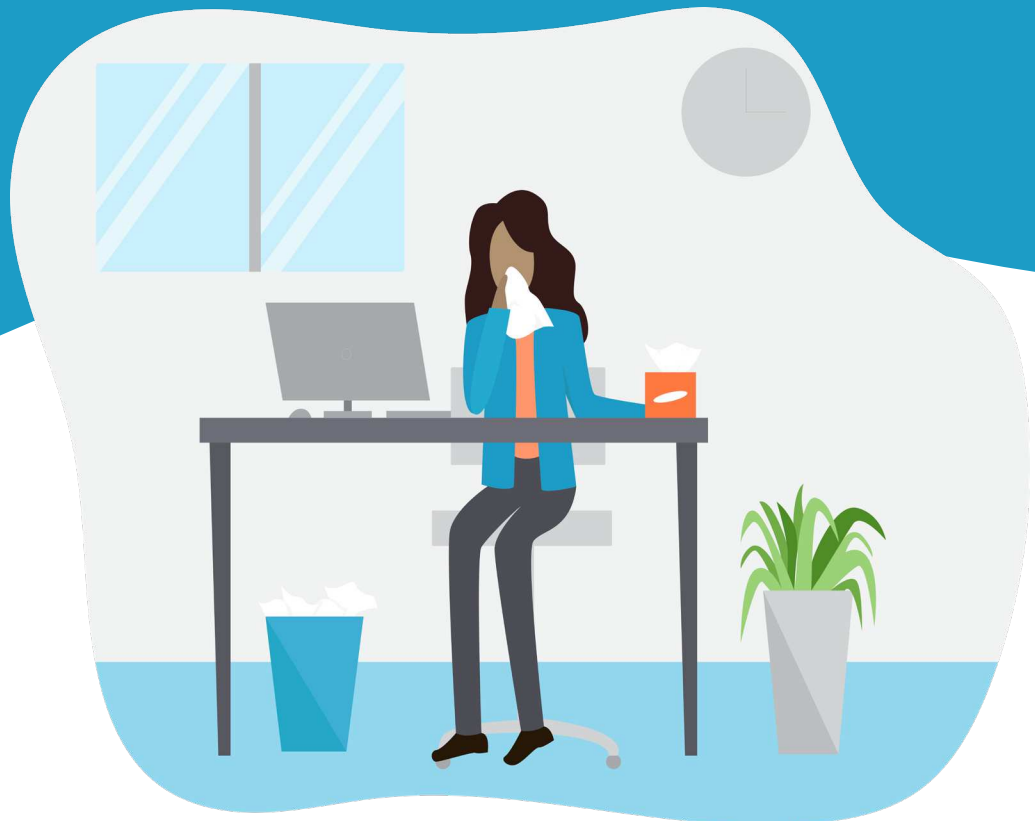


Flu Management in The Workplace
